Transcript

The Honorable Deputy President M. Naor:

Instead of sending the petitioners to submit applications, you have all the material before you, we suggest that you consider the matter. Transfer it to any one you wish and we will leave the matter open. Otherwise we will keep the *Order Nisi* in force.

Do whatever you want provided that a decision is given. How much time do you need?

Advocate Epstein:

It is difficult to commit to a certain date because it depends on additional parties other than the Ministry of Interior.
