Resolution Subject: Nationality and Entry into Israel Law (Temporary Order) 5763-2003 – Validity

Extension

Hereby resolves: A. In accordance with Article 5 of the Nationality and Entry into Israel Law

(Temporary Order) 5763-2003 (hereinafter – the law), to extend the term of validity

of the law for one year until 10 Av 5769 (31 July 2009).

B. To present the order for extension of the law as aforesaid to the Knesset for

authorization.

C. In accordance with Article 3d of the law and based on the opinion of the authorized security personnel, to determine that the Gaza Strip is a region where activity which may endanger the security of the State of Israel and its citizens takes place, and therefore, the government instructs the Minister of the Interior or whomever appointed by him not to approve the granting of permits for residency in Israel or temporary permits to remain in Israel as per Articles 3 and 3-A(2) of the law to persons registered in the population registry as residents of the Gaza Strip and anyone residing in the Gaza Strip despite not being registered in the population registry as a resident of the Gaza Strip.

It is hereby clarified that this Article shall apply hereinafter and does not apply in any case to persons whose initial application has already been approved.
